Presentation of Small Molecule Screening Project

- In late November 2018, Dr. Reynold Panettieri was selected to have prioritized access to the Small Molecule Screening Developing Shared Resource for a research project that demonstrated cancer relevance and strong possibility of garnering peer-reviewed funding. One of the terms of this awarded prioritized access was that he would present on his research at a Research Leadership Council meeting at least six months after the beginning of his project.
- On October 3, 2019, Dr. Panettieri presented on his research to members of the Research Leadership Council, Shared Resources leaders from Rutgers University and Princeton University, and other leaders from Rutgers University who could advise on potential next steps for the research.
- Dr. Panettieri's presentation indicated several key findings that would be opportunities for further exploration. The meeting attendees asked multiple questions about his project. They had strong positive feedback about the possibilities for his current research project and future scientific investigation. His initial findings, the potential for future research, and the scientific support obtained from Small Molecule Screening Center Director Hahn Kim demonstrated the strategic investment made by Rutgers Cancer Institute in this developing Shared Resource.
