Urgent Issues/New Business (Team)				
Deputy Director Report (Dr. White)	Faculty recruitments are occurring through the Cancer Immunology and Metabolism Center of Excellence and the Ludwig-Princeton Branch. The recruitment process seems to have changed. Faculty Affairs needs to ensure that the faculty search committees fully understand the expectations (e.g., details of the position for which candidates are being considered) so that the committees can be appropriately charged. There was agreement about the urgent need to replace H. Khiabanian. This position has already been approved for recruitment. It was noted that diversity within the faculty search committees is crucial and it was confirmed that the newly formed basic research faculty search committee sufficiently represents the diversity goal The Faculty Affairs and DEI Offices are working to have a better pipeline for more	L. CCSG Submission (Team)	L. Tanzer reported that all CCSG grant sections received external review. Data reconciliation changes in the form of minor, small adjustments occurring (e.g., final clinical trials numbers). E. White asked about the final funding numbers and L. Tanzer reported that all of the Research Programs continued to show strong metrics, as did the Consortium and the Cancer Center overall. The Data Tables have been completed and some additional proofreading by ADs would be welcome. The Program Leaders have been getting sent their final Programmatic Activities Lists. Dr. Libutti is reviewing all sections and recommending changes.	G. Londino-Greenberg will send out Data Tables to appropriate ADs for review.		

Website Update (Londino- Greenberg/Tanzer)	The external vendor to update the CINJ website has been engaged. Communications anticipates having new versions of the website pages within a week. There was discussion of the need for the resident PI's admins to keep their laboratory pages updated on a rolling basis. The question of whether admin support could help with updating PIs' myNCBI publications lists. While the admins can act as delegates and help to identify compliance issues, publications linked to the PIs are uploaded by the journals. Admins can also help to keep complete of PIs'	G. Shared Resources (Berger)	There was discussion around issues with the Comprehensive Genomics SR in Newark. A. Berger explained that the matter was being investigated. Efforts are also underway to hire a staff member for this SR to help lower the turnaround time and an assessment of the chargebacks for the services will be performed to ensure that they are competitive with that of external vendors. A. Kinney advised that the CPODS SR should "sunset" its current version of DatStat for an upgraded version that works similar to how OnCore does for clinical trials.
