“Visualization of Skin Treatment Effects In-vivo”

Abstract:

Prolonged time between start of treatment and clinically appreciable results can be distressing or frustrating to patients. However, subclinical improvements can be measured by histopathological parameters. Reflectance confocal microscopy (RCM) is a non-invasive imaging tool that has predominantly been utilized in the diagnosis and evaluation of skin cancers, however it shows great promise for treatment monitoring in various dermatological conditions.
