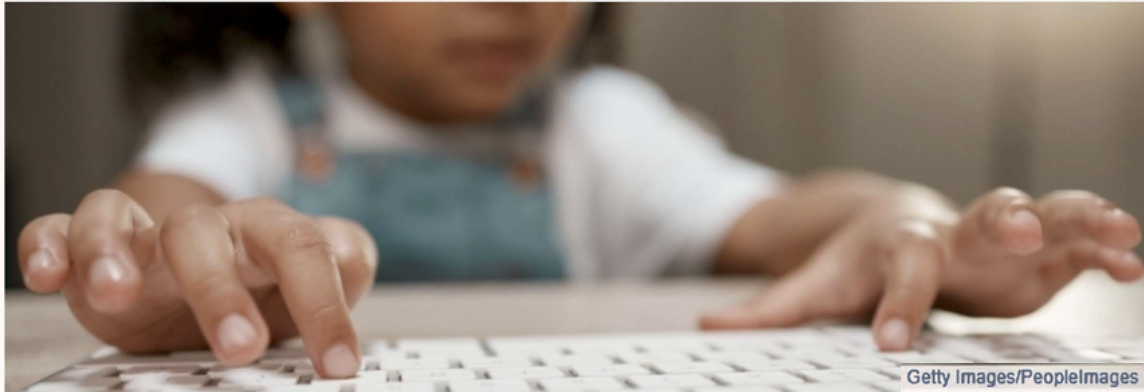


TWO "TROUBLESHOOTING" WORKSHOPS ON TEACHING AND GENERATIVE AI: 9/29 AND 10/3
