RE: Undergraduate Updates

Dear BME Undergraduates,

I hope everyone had a nice Spring Break and is ready for the final stretch of the semester! Hopefully, this nice weather is here to stay! Please see below for some important updates.

FALL 2021 SEMESTER

An unapproved course schedule was prematurely released and not finalized, and has since been removed.

Registration does not open until April 19th and the department will have the chance to review and correct any scheduling conflicts prior to its official release.

By now, we have all seen the email from President Holloway stating: "In support of Rutgers' commitment to health and safety for all members of its community, the University will be updating its Immunization Requirements for Students to include the COVID-19 vaccine." Attached to this newsletter is a university FAQ which should address any questions.

A reminder to <u>Sophomores:</u> When registration opens, please be mindful of your Junior requirements. You must complete 6/8 Junior core, including the labs, in order to register for senior design. Devices lab is only offered in the fall! Measurements is offered in the spring and, at least for now, in the summer. Please refer to the BME Handbook if you need guidance on what classes you should be taking and check your Degree Navigator to make sure you are on track. You do not want to risk delaying graduation because you did not meet the requirements for Senior Design, and the Department is very firm on this policy!

A reminder to **ALL STUDENTS** that <u>summer internships</u>, <u>co-ops and research</u> can count towards your <u>technical elective</u> <u>credits!</u> Please refer to the BME Handbook for guidelines. There is a form that has to be filled out <u>PRIOR</u> to starting your job/research so the experience can be approved. Forms for research, internship and co-op credit can be found (guess where...) in the BME Handbook!

SENIOR DESIGN

Senior design is the final, year-long capstone project and lecture required to graduate. All seniors should register for the lecture component (401) for the fall. Registration for the project component of senior design (421) is done through SPN with your project advisor. Given some of the uncertainty with Fall semester planning, the project selection process has been delayed and we expect to post information on the process mid-April. Projects are typically completed by teams of 4-6 students. While you can begin to assemble teams to apply to projects, being accepted as a team is up to the discretion of the advisor. On the flip-side, if you do not have a team assembled you can apply to projects without groupmates. The information release in April will contain information on how to proceed with selecting projects. Keep your eyes open for posting in your Junior-level core classes (303/304/305/306/308) for more information. If you are not in one of the Junior core classes and plan on participating in senior design next year, please contact Dr. Sy.

COMBINED DEGREE PROGRAM
