Dear BME Undergraduates,

I hope everyone had a relaxing break, and that your semester is off to a great start!

<u>SENIORS</u>-this is your last semester! Hopefully everyone is wrapping up their departmental electives and any other outstanding requirements. As a reminder, graduate level BME classes can count as departmental electives. In order to take a graduate class, you need a minimum 3.0 GPA, need permission from the instructor in writing, and then you can forward that email to Ms. Connors for the SPN. <u>econnors@soe.rutgers.edu</u>

<u>JUNIORS</u>: you should be finishing your junior core this semester. EVERY Junior should be in Measurements Lab. Also an important reminder about our 6/8 rule; **you cannot take senior design without passing 6/8 junior core**, including both lab classes. If for some reason you are behind, we are offering 3 junior core this summer; Biomaterials, Numerical Modeling, and Transport.

Please note that the 6/8 rule is a minimum requirement but in order to be fully on track with the curriculum and not compromise any department electives you wish to take, you should do your best to complete the Junior core in the Junior year.

You will also be getting a LOT of information at the end of this semester. Dr. Freeman, graduate director, will be sending out information about the **Combined Degree Program**, however you can find information on the new and improved BME website: <u>https://bme.rutgers.edu/combined-bsms-degree</u>

The other big question is; How do I get matched to a team for Senior Design?

In March, Dr. Kyker-Snowman will post a list of available projects, with descriptions. You will use this list to identify projects that are of interest to you, and then contact the advisors for those projects to ask whether there is room on their Senior Design team. IMPORTANT: Once you have confirmed that there is room on the team you would like to join and have committed to it, please send an email to Dr. K-S with your team advisor on the email as well. Some of these projects will fill quickly! Everyone will have a project by the beginning of fall semester 2025, but it is your responsibility to reach out to the project(s) that you would like to join.

<u>SOPHOMORES</u>: all sophomores need to complete both Intro to BME and BME Systems Physiology before you can start any junior core. BOTH of these classes will be offered this summer if anyone needs to catch up.

REMINDERS:

ADD/DROP ends JANUARY 30th so if anyone needs to make a change to accommodate any of the above policies, you have until then to modify your schedule.
