  - E.g., if the output includes a table reporting t-values and p-values, the t-value should appear in the “t-value” column and the p-value should appear in the “p-value” column.
  - \*\* Variables should be labeled by what they are. They should not be called “variable” or “var1.” Score on an IQ test might be labeled “IQ.”
