## **Bachelor of Music: Composition Concentration Requirement Notes**

- + The total number of credits required for graduation for the Composition Concentration is 124. Because the 8 credits for Music Assembly do not count towards graduation, and the 4 credits for *Classroom Piano* (although not required) are included in the semester credit totals, the grand total of required course credits add up to more than 124 credits.
- ~ Registration in Music Assembly is required in every semester of registration in Applied Major Lessons.
- Students must follow the music and Liberal Arts course requirements in effect at the time of the student's initial year of enrollment.
- \* In addition to a 60-minute Composition Senior Recital, an annual Composition Portfolio Review is also required for Composition majors. The senior recital cannot be scheduled if a student has a grade of Unsatisfactory in any semester of *Music Assembly*.
- \*\* All Bachelor of Music students (with the exception of classical piano majors) must take the Piano Proficiency Exam by the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year and must pass the exam in order to graduate. Courses in piano are available to prepare students for this examination.
- # Composition Majors are required to take 2 semesters of *Rutgers New Music Workshop* (07:701:307) and 2 semesters Chamber Music. The chamber music requirement can be satisfied either by the *Chamber Music* course (07:701:355, 356, 455, or 456) or by one of the small ensembles listed in the Music Undergraduate Handbook (other than *Rutgers New Music Workshop*).

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
