GENEVIEVE LLOYD'S MAN OF REASON

"When the Man of Reason is extolled, philosophers are not talking about idealizations of human beings. They are talking about ideals of manhood" (18).




Enchanted songs exclusive to *women*

I don't enjoy it here squatting on this island looking picturesque and mythical with these two feathery maniacs, I don't enjoy singing this trio, fatal and valuable.


I will tell the secret to you, to you, only to you. Come closer. This song

The siren is a **DECEITFUL LIAR**




She's a bird-human hybrid that pretends to hate the fact that her "irresistible" song lures men to their deaths

Women are shown to be confident and beautiful temptresses in nature

as sexual, and are shown to be victims of the women's sexuality

HOW SO? WELL...



When the idea that women's confidence and beauty automatically entails that she wants to attract men is normalized in the media, men internalize this thought and see all confident, beautiful women as threatening sexual objects






When these confident women refuse to lure these men by means of their beauty with sex, men are more likely to do as they please with the woman under the guise that they are the victims of temptation because they believe all beautiful women want to attract men, but some are harder to get



GENDER SHIFT in the Media's Depictions of Sea Creatures

Mercreatures are seen as **GOOD**, and merge the worlds between sea and land

As the media increases its depiction of mercreatures, the sexualization of women has **decreased** and **more** men have become included

· Disney's THE LITTLE MERMAID



Men like King Triton are shown to have direct power and control over women's actions, rather than being shown to be victims of the female allure

While this does not *directly* perpetuate the *sexualization of women* or the *victimization of men*, this does reinforce the idea that men can control a woman's sexuality
