




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What is the 3q29 deletion?

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Rare Syndrome: 1 in 30,000 in the general population

3q29 Microdeletion Syndrome: Clinical and Molecular Characterization of a New Syndrome


- Willatt et al, AJHG 2005 describes six patients
- All have mild to moderate ID and language delay
- "Autism was a feature of the behavior of two of the patients"

Expanding the clinical phenotype of the 3q29 microdeletion syndrome and characterization of the reciprocal microduplication

- Ballif et al 2008, Mol Cytogenetics: 14 patients
- Mild to moderate ID the only feature common to all patients
- Speech Delay (53%)
- Autism/autistic features (27%)
- Recurrent ear infections, heart defects, widely spaced teeth (13%)


