

### PROFESSIONAL ATTIRE

Dress professionally to make a good first impression.

DO WEAR: Dark gray, navy blue, or black business DO WEAR: A blouse or a solid white/lightprofessional suit with full sleeve and matching pants or knee-length skirt.

DO NOT WEAR: Light-colored or ill-fitting suits, short skirts, or dresses.

DO WEAR: Clean, polished dress shoes or closed

DO NOT WEAR: White or short socks, sandals, boots, sneakers, flip flops, or other openedcolored button-up, collared shirt with a tie. A black or neutral headcovering.







DO NOT WEAR: Tight, ill-fitting shirts, plunging necklines, stripes or bright prints/colors.

### ACCESSORIES





DO WEAR: Professional accessories, but keep it to a minimum, belts should match the color of your shoes and attire.

DO NOT WEAR: Offensive accessories.

### GROOMING



DO BE: Well-groomed, have makeup and fragrances kept to a minimum, and keep nails clean and well-maintained.

DO NOT BE: Rumpled, unkempt, disheveled.


