

Introduction

CITI training provides computer-based instruction and testing on various areas of research ethics and regulatory compliance. CITI courses are free and do not require user ID from RWJMS to enroll. Anyone can create a profile in the "Rutgers – The State University of New Jersey" CITI account; personal email address is acceptable.

CITI courses include human subjects research, good clinical practice, HIPAA, and the responsible conduct of research (including academic integrity topics such as plagiarism and falsification of data). They are presented in a series of modules; therefore they do not have to be completed in one sitting. They may be exited and reentered as often as needed to complete the selected modules, with all progress being saved after each exit. You are required to complete the Biomedical Research Basic Course and the Responsible Conduct of Research Course.

Once a course is completed, a completion report is available for printing from the learner's menu. Human subjects courses are valid for three years. After the expiration of the required Basic course, individuals must either take the refresher course or retake the basic course. The average learner spends approximately 4-5 hours to complete the Biomedical Research Basic Course and the Responsible Conduct of Research Course (with approximately 5 logins to complete the course).

You are required to upload a copy of both of your CERTIFICATES (not completion reports) into the ExamSoft portal. During the orientation week, you will be introduced to ExamSoft and you will receive an email with detailed instructions to upload your certificates from Year 1 Coordinator, Ms. Wadee'ah Terry. If you have completed CITI training through another institution, you do not have to complete the CITI training again but please submit your certificate of completion into the ExamSoft porta as described. If all modules were not completed at your previous institution, then you must log into CITI and complete those modules not completed previously. Please note that institutions may differ in the modules included in the Basic course and the responsible conduct course.

Check the lists on the *last two* pages of these instructions to ensure that you have completed all necessary modules within each course that are required at RWJMS.






