

Enhancing Mental Health Services for Students: Comprehensive School Mental Health Coaching and Supports Project SY 2023-2025

NJ-CSMHCS Project Overview

The **NJ-CSMHCS Project** is a collaborative effort between the New Jersey Department of Education and the Rutgers Center for Comprehensive School-Based Mental Health (Rutgers-CCSMH). This project builds on the New Jersey Comprehensive School Mental Health Resource Guide released in 2022. The NJ-CSMHCS Project will support the implementation of comprehensive school mental health systems in schools across the state. Our extensive approach includes the launch of the New Jersey School Mental Health Leadership Academy and intensive technical assistance for 50 New Jersey schools.

Sponsored by the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE), Division of Educational Services, in collaboration with the Department of Psychiatric Rehabilitation and Counseling Professions Center for Comprehensive School Mental Health at Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey; 100% funded by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 – Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund.

Benefits to Participating Schools

- ✓ Receive assistance in conducting a formal assessment of your current comprehensive school mental health (CSMH) system, identifying areas of strength and a concrete action plan for improvement.
- ✓ Obtain **no cost-free intensive technical assistance (TA) and training**, both in a group format with other schools and individualized to meet the unique needs of your school.
- ✓ Gain access to a collaborative peer community to support developing and implementing a CSMH system.
- ✓ Build **internal capacity and expertise** within your school or district to support the **implementation and sustainability** of a CSMH system.
- ✓ Receive assistance administering school mental health screeners to identify student strengths and needs.

School selection is a competitive application process. Completed applications must be received by **Monday, May 15** to be considered for participation. Applicants will be notified in June 2023.

Application Checklist

- ✓ Complete application request
- Secure administrative and staff buy-in and support
- ✓ Gather requested school data

- ✓ Consult with relevant school mental health staff or teams
- ✓ Provide thorough and complete responses
- ✓ Submit application by May 15 deadline

Project Timeline (2023-2025)

Training and technical assistance sessions may be held in-person or virtually depending on need and capacity. School Mental Health Leads (SMH Leads) and the Comprehensive School Mental Health Teams (CSMH Teams) will receive training.

Training topics may include: developing an Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) framework and aligning initiatives within a MTSS framework, teaming, conducting needs assessments, resource mapping, and establishing universal interventions (Tier 1), strategies for effective school-based mental health coaching, risk assessment, and establishing targeted interventions (Tiers 2 and 3).
