




Day of Action on Reproductive Justice

IMPORTANT Updates

- General Pre-Approval is no longer required effective immediately
 - You will still need honorarium and pre-allocation pre-approval
- International honoraria are temporarily suspended
 - Your speaker must have a valid USA SSN



Pre-approval removed notice...

- COVID Pre-Approval is no longer required for in-person events
 - Honorarium pre-approval is still required!!
- If you are unsure about certain purchases or event details, and want to discuss in advance if your event is appropriate and can be funded, email ec@gsa.rutgers.edu with specific questions.

IF YOUR POST EVENT REPORT DOES NOT CONTAIN APPROPRIATE JUSTIFICATION OF FUNDS (receipts, official sign-in sheets, advertising materials, completed PER pages, etc), GSA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DENY REIMBURSEMENT. THIS IS IN OUR CONSTITUTION AND FUNDING GUIDELINES.



IMPORTANT REMINDER

As stated in the GSA Constitution, GSOs must hold <u>at least</u> one (1) event per semester that all GSA constituents are welcome to attend. If this is not met, the GSO's recognition will be revoked.

This will be enforced again starting this semester (Fall 2022).

See GSA Constitution Article IV., Section A, Subsection 6.a.



Funding and Recognition AY 2022-2023

- Approved GSOs' Total Annual Entitlements will posted by tonight at midnight.
 - All allocations are <u>pending submission of funding contract</u> and <u>pending any outstanding</u> <u>issues with the application materials</u>
 - Most common issues:
 - Constitution and/or getINVOLVED page does not explicitly state that membership and events are open to all graduate students
 - Academic GSOs missing academic and departmental code information
 - Redundancy between groups
 - Eboard contact information missing
 - Funding Contract will be posted tonight on GSA getINVOLVED
- Check your GSO's Funding and Recognition application submission to view comments from the GSA EC and make necessary changes.
 - o GSO's have until <u>a OCTOBER 31st, 2022</u> to submit the corrections and updates.

Pleased to announce: All recognized GSOs were funded <u>100%</u> of their allowed request! Thank you to all who applied and all who requested reasonable amounts of funding.



Late Groups Funding

If you missed the deadline, you can still apply for Late Groups Funding!

- \$1000 entitlements
- Rolling basis until funding pool is exhausted



What can I do if my GSO may need more funds to hold the events we want to hold?

- Collaborate with other GSOs for events
 - Use Discord channel #collaborations
- Request co-sponsorship with GSA if the event would be of interest to all graduate students (case-by-case basis)
 - Email ec@gsa.rutgers.edu to discuss



GSO Spending Tracker

- Use <u>provided template</u> for tracking GSO spending
 - Including honoraria!
 - Including events held that did not use funding!
- Required to submit twice/academic year
 - Fall Submission due December 31st, 2022
 - Spring Submission TBD




