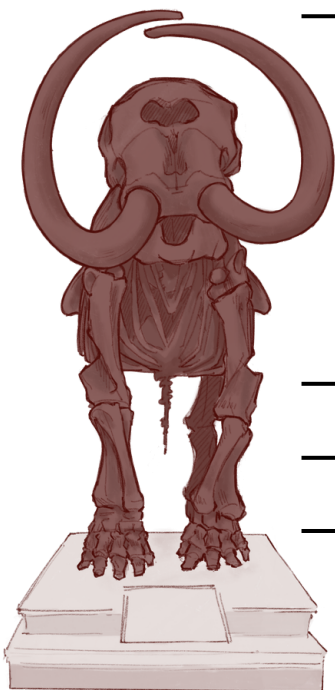


Manny's Poetic Adventure

Poetry Vocabulary

Word	Definition
Rhyme	The repetition or similarity in sounds at the ends of words Example: tooth and booth or clap and slap
Simile	When two unlike things are compared using the words like or as. Example: Her hair was as yellow as straw.
Metaphor	When two unlike things are compared to make a statement. Example: He was an elephant, the way he walked.
Repetition	Repeating the same word or phrase in a poem.
Stanza	Lines that are grouped together in a poem for emphasis and/or shared meaning.
End Mark	When a line of a poem ends with punctuation for emphasis.
Theme	An overall idea present in a piece of literature.
Anaphora	A special type of repetition where the same word or short phrase is repeated at the beginning of poetic lines. Example: He was bold./He was brave./He was strong.
Hyperbole	Exaggerated statements made for emphasis. Example: Those shoes were so expensive they cost a trillion dollars!
Alliteration	The repetition of sounds in words. Example: Sally sells seashells down by the sea shore.
Personification	When non human things are given human attributes. Example: Manny said "Hello friend."
