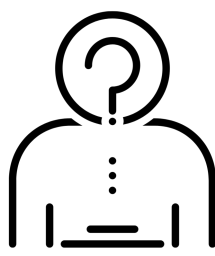


American Journal of Psychiatry Article: What are the risks with discontinuing long-term buprenorphine use?

JAMA Letter: Do residential treatment programs routinely offer MAT?



A "secret shopper" **audit** found that only 29% of the 368 residential treatment programs randomly sampled offered maintenance buprenorphine, 31% offered MAT for only short-term detoxification, 21% discouraged the use of MAT, and nearly 40% did not offer MAT or were unclear about its availability.
