Naloxone also goes by the brand names of "Narcan" and "Evzio"*

Pharmacy

Some pharmacies require a prescription for you to get naloxone, while some can offer the medication whether or not you have a prescription.

Some pharmacies in Newark that do not require a prescription are:

Bergen Pharmacy on Lyons Ave, Campus Pharmacy, Clinton Pharmacy & Healthcare, CVS on Bloomfield Ave, Gateway Pharmacy, Rite Aid on 12th Ave and on Ferry St, Shoprite on Springfield Ave, Most Walgreens locations

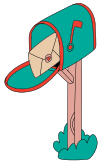
