The Project is expected to deliver a total of up to \$12 billion in economic benefits and jobs to New Jersey over the lifetime of the Project\*

## **Community Coalitions**

# Piloting a hyper-local engagement and economic development model through local advisory boards

Attentive Energy is organizing community-based organizations and small businesses within specific geographies to create a model for local advisory and engagement

- Monthly meetings with Coalition members to share project updates, build member familiarity with the industry, and enhance Attentive Energy's understanding of local issues and interests related to offshore wind
- Attentive Energy has committed funds to support local programming related to offshore wind and post-award funds to create local workforce, education, and business technical assistance for local residents

#### The Coalition model is being piloted in Paulsboro, Salem, and Elizabeth, NJ

- Coalition members include the local chambers of commerce, school boards, nonprofits, faith-based organizations, and small businesses; to date, 17 unique local organizations are part of the Coalitions with more to be added in the coming months
- Additional engagement being done to organize Coalitions in other parts of the State
- Findings will be shared with the industry to minimize stakeholder engagement fatigue and build trust with local communities
