Whether you choose to join or not, here are some retiree benefits that you may want to prioritize:

RETIREE EMAIL ACCOUNT

Retirees may establish a retiree email account through Scarletmail. To set up your retiree email account, please visit <u>netid.rutgers.edu</u>. On the first screen, please select Service Activation. On the next screen, please choose ScarletApps. You will be prompted to confirm your netid and password. Once netid and password have been confirmed, you will receive a message indicating that your Scarletmail account has been established. Your new email address will be your netid@scarletmail.rutgers.edu. For technical assistance in creating your scarletmail account, please contact the Rutgers OIT HelpDesk at 848-932-4357.

RETIREE PARKING

As a retiree, you may arrange for free retiree parking in any of the non-gated lots on campus. To arrange your retiree parking, please visit <u>DOTSHELP.rutgers.edu</u> Select GET HELP to complete your request. Please be sure to provide your vehicle information (make, model, color of vehicle and license plate number).
