Eligibility

Students must be

- based on the Rutgers Newark or New Brunswick campus
- undergraduate or graduate students who will continue at either institution in Fall 2025
- enrolled in degree programs in the earth & environmental science related disciplines, including but not limited to Environmental Science, Ecology & Evolution, Ocean Science, Earth & Planetary Sciences, Atmospheric Sciences, Microbiology
- committed to participating for 2-4 hours per week over an 8-week period
- identify with groups that are traditionally underrepresented in the Geosciences.
